ANCIENT IFIELD



Ewhurst Place is the only complete survivor of the six known moated manors in the Crawley area, that is the complete moat and the house still exist. The current building is a grade 2* listed L-shaped timber-framed house of 2 storeys and attics occupying the north-west angle of the moated enclosure with the main range lying east to west which was probably built in the late 1500s. The south side, or the 'tail' of the L is faced with 18th century brick and it is believed that this marks a small extension of perhaps 3 metres at the point of the original entrance to the house. An external door frame can still be seen inside the building.
